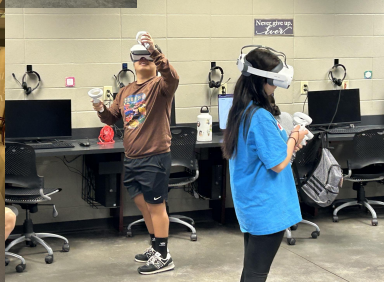
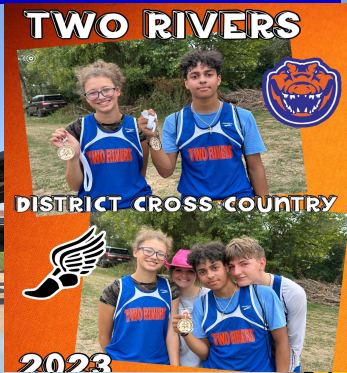

Earn your credits on time.



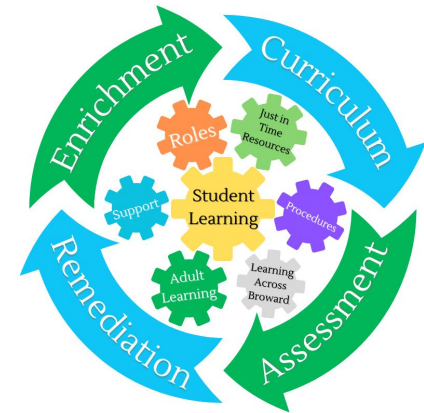

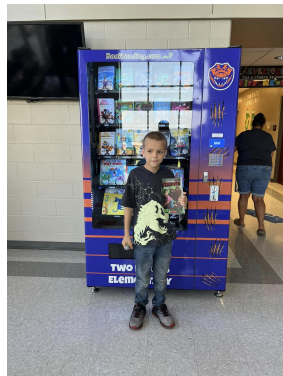
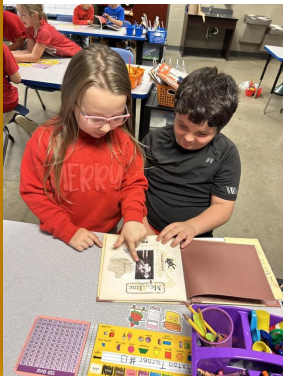

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Home Access Center (HAC) is an online portal that allows parents/guardians to log in and view information pertaining to their student(s) attendance, classes, grades, and registration information.

 <b>Home</b>	
<b>Week View</b>	Displays a student's attendance, scheduling, and assignment information for the current week, as well as activities and events. Previous and future weeks can also be displayed. Links are provided for viewing scores and details on individual courses and assignments.
<b>Calendar</b>	Displays a month-view of the student's attendance, scheduling, and assignment information, as well as activities and events. Previous and future months can also be displayed.
 <b>Attendance</b>	
<b>Month View</b>	Displays a month-view of the student's attendance that can be toggled to access all months within the current school year. A color legend identifies the type of attendance displayed. Place the mouse pointer over a day to view detailed information on absence information.
 <b>Classes</b>	
<b>Classwork</b>	Displays course assignments, including the dates assigned, due dates, categories, potential points, and scores for Gradebook assignments, as well as the overall percentage.  Teachers select whether an assignment and its score should be published for HAC. Unpublished assignments/scores are not included in the displayed student's average for a course.
<b>Schedule</b>	Displays the student's schedule for the entire year. Links are provided for viewing detailed course information and sending emails to teachers.

## Grades

<b>Interim Progress Report</b>	Displays the student's most recent interim progress report, including courses, marks, and comments for an IPR run. If comments were entered for the student, a comment legend displays below the course information. In addition, you can select to view any previous IPR run for the current year.
<b>Report Cards</b>	Displays information from the student's most recent report card run. The page lists marks and comments related to the student's courses.  Additional information includes the sum of earned credits for the report card run, current, semester, and cumulative credits and GPAs. If comments were entered for the student, a comment legend appears below the report card information. In addition, you can select to view any previous report card run for the current year.
<b>Transcript</b>	Displays the student's transcript information.



## Registration

<b>Demographic</b>	Displays the student's basic demographic information, including date of birth, gender, grade, building, house/team, and counselor. Additional information displays, such as contact information, student and guardian addresses and phone numbers, transportation to and from school, and sensitive information from the Personal page.
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## User Options



<b>My Account</b>	Allows guardians and students to change their email address, HAC passwords and modify the challenge questions that are asked when users forget their passwords.
<b>Logoff</b>	Closes the current HAC session, and returns you to the Log On page.
<b>Change Student</b>	Allows guardians who have two or more students to display a pop-up window for selecting another student.

**Guardian E-Mail Address:** guardians are encouraged (*not required*) to provide an e-mail address. A valid e-mail address associated with the guardian will allow retrieval / reset of the password using the "Forgot My Username or Password" login feature. Providing an email address will also enable direct email communication between guardian and teacher.
