Qualifications/Requirements:

- Master's degree from a graduate school of social work program. A minimum of a 500 clock hour supervised social work practicum.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Performs case work service with individual students to correct those personal, social or emotional maladjustments related to their educational and social progress
- Coordinate or serve as a member of diagnostic teams and educational planning and placement committees and provide biological, psychological and sociological assessment information related to planning for children adjustment problems
- Consults and collaborates with other school personnel in gathering and giving information on a case, and in establishing and planning for respective roles in the modification of the student's behavior
- Performs casework service with parents as an integral part of the task of helping students, to increase the parents' understanding, their constructive participation in resolving their child's problems and their knowledge and use of appropriate resources available
- Makes home visits for the purpose of gathering helpful information on a student's background
- Assists students directly toward adjustment to school
- Supports both special education and general education students
- Other duties as assigned
