Greetings Collinsville High School patrons,

Please read this letter completely. There will be information that affects all CHS students.

I would like to take the opportunity to communicate our plan for administering the ACT, US History, and Science assessments to our **Junior class** this spring. We have found through experience that conditions for testing are much better and have far fewer distractions when only those students taking the test are in attendance. The required state-mandated tests for Juniors will take place as follows.

On **Thursday, March 28, 2024, and Friday, March 29, 2024**, Junior students will be required to have their Chromebook checked by the IT department in the library during their English class. **Virtual/blended students** will need to make plans to bring their Chromebook to the CHS Library on that day between 8:30-3:00, so we can make sure your Chromebook is compliant for the test.

On the following testing dates, junior students will be expected to arrive no later than 8:20 a.m. with their Chromebook **fully charged**. Students should bring their Chromebook charger, number 2 pencils, and an ACT-approved calculator. Click on the following link for approved calculators. The ACT® Calculator Policy

On **Tuesday**, **April 2**, **2024**, all juniors will report to their scheduled testing room no later than 8:20 a.m. for the state CCRA US History and Science tests. Testing room assignments will be posted in the commons area and at the main entrance and emailed to the students.

On **Tuesday, April 9, 2023**, juniors will again report to their scheduled testing room no later than 8:20 a.m. for the ACT. Testing room assignments will be posted in the commons area and at the main entrance and emailed to the students.

FRESHMEN, SOPHOMORE, AND SENIOR INFORMATION

All freshmen, sophomores, and senior students will experience a "Virtual Day" and not report to campus on April 2nd and April 9th. As determined by the teacher, these students will access

assignments and lessons through Google Classroom or other platforms. Attendance will be recorded from their login. All seniors that have concurrent courses or courses at Tulsa Tech will still attend those sites.
