School-wide Planning- Title I Status

Schools with large concentrations of students enrolled in the free/reduced lunch program are eligible to receive Title I funds to assist in meeting students' educational goals. In order to qualify for school-wide status, 40% of students must be enrolled in the free/reduced lunch program.

The purpose of the Title I program is to ensure **all** students receive a free and equal opportunity to obtain a high quality education and reach proficiency on state academic assessments.

- Hire Instructional Facilitators, Instructional Assistants, and Point in Time Interventionists to work with struggling students.

- Provides additional PD, training, for teachers to better enable them to support students.
- Have funds to increase family engagement- ideas for use of these funds?


