

Diagnostic services

- The staff of our diagnostic clinic are trained to diagnose a broad range of conditions that might appear during childhood, adolescence, or adulthood.
- Assessment for Autism Spectrum Disorders is also available through the diagnostic clinic. Our clinic is a member of TAP—a state-wide network of autism providers. Funding for such services is provided in whole or in part by The Autism Program of Illinois and the Illinois Department of Human Services
- The assessment process typically begins with an initial screening, which helps to determine whether further assessment will be helpful and facilitates other initial recommendations
- A comprehensive diagnostic assessment helps to clarify diagnosis and to generate a list of recommendations that provide direction regarding what treatments and other resources may be sought to address presenting concerns.

Individual Counseling

Therapists and counselors can assist a person struggling with:

Child and Adolescent Services

The Trinity Counseling Center delivers well-researched interventions for childhood behavior disorders. The center serves all children, including victims of abuse and children coping with parents' divorce. The center treats:

- ADHD
- Self-esteem issues
- Conduct disorders
- Oppositional and defiant behaviors
- Childhood anxiety and depression.



Family Therapy & Couples' Counseling

Marriage and family therapists are experienced staff trained to assess the best way to attend to needs of the family or couple and provide solution-focused interventions. Therapists encourage attainable, therapeutic goals that aid the best outcome for every person involved. They also provide parent coaching and assistance to improve communication among family members.

Divorce Mediation

Mediation offers a positive and future-focused way to resolve disputes. Participants take an active role in making durable decisions and agreements. The average mediation is finalized in a few hours, making mediation an efficient and cost-effective option. Our mediators are approved by the Will County Court. We work with divorce, separation, custody and visitation.

Affordable Fees
