SENIOR PARENTS

Graduation will be here before you know it.
Here is what you can do to prepare this month:

1. Check with your child on **scholarships** they have applied for and make sure they are tracking this in their rolling portfolio. We will need this for Senior Showcase on May 20th. The deadline for updates is May 17th.
2. April 1-5 is C.A.P. (College Application Week). Check with your child on their progress towards college.
3. We will have the Senior Showcase May 20th and hope that you will all attend!

JUNIOR PARENTS

1. Now is the time to start planning college visits for your child's senior year! Each senior gets 2 college visit days and we have lots of opportunities through the school to visit colleges.
2. Ask your child to see their Rolling Portfolio and how they plan to use it in college and job applications.



FRESHMAN AND SOPHOMORE PARENTS

April conversations to have with your child:

1. Academic habits tend to slip in the spring. Check with your child on how they are tracking assignments, how they are studying for tests and other assessments, and most importantly how they are doing with rest!
2. Check with your child on any failed classes they may have had this year that need to be made-up. We have lots of opportunities for credit recovery.
3. Schedules for 24-25 are open in the Infinite Campus portal and your child has also gotten a paper copy. Any change that needs to be made can be made through August 16th.
4. PCHS is 1:1 school meaning that your child has a Chromebook that they are responsible for from freshman year through senior year. Check with your child that they are treating this device appropriately.
