Title III LEP:

NCSD used funding to supplement academic supports for EL students, supporting them in obtaining academic standards. Toolkits were purchased to provide structured activities in listening, reading, writing and speaking in support of mastering the academic language. EL interventionists are being trained through book studies on best practices and training local staff. A family engagement rep. was placed at the largest high school in the district to support students, families and staff in addressing barriers to EL student academic performance as it relates to; attendance, grades, parent engagement, etc. Families are also provided with additional assistance in local and state assessments, parent teachers conferences, availability of educational programming outside the scope of the regular school day and other opportunities that will enhance student success.
