Happy Moo Year! Welcome back. We hope you had a fun break! We're excited to give you an update on **Maple Gardner**. She is now five months old, weighs 325 pounds, and is growing quickly! She'll continue to grow until she's about 2 years old, which is when she'll have her first calf. Once she has her first calf, she'll start producing milk. Cows are milked in a building called a milking parlor. Most dairy farmers use machines to milk their cows, which is faster and easier for the cows and the farmer. On average, a dairy cow produces 8 gallons of milk per day—that's more than 100 glasses of milk!
