If your student has bluish lips or face, extreme difficulty breathing, severe dizziness, disorientation, or is unconscious or difficult to wake, contact 911 IMMEDIATELY! These are life-threatening symptoms.



All students will have assigned seating. Buses will continue to be disinfected regularly. (Each bus has been equipped with an air purification system.)



Serving lines will be open and students will resume eating in the cafeteria. All GDPH safety guidelines will be followed.



School visitors will be allowed on a limited basis. Masks will be encouraged/not required. Virtual conferencing will continue to be available.



Hand sanitizing will be available throughout all facilities.



Bottle refill stations (touchless) have been added to all water fountains.



All learning will be faceto-face for the 23-24 school year.



Classrooms will have seating assignments and will be regularly disinfected. Highly concentrated areas (i.e., lunchroom, locker rooms, band room, etc.) have "air scrubbers" installed in the duct work. All HVAC units at LKMES have been replaced with units that greatly reduce pathogens.



Students and employees may be quarantined. **GDPH** guidelines will be followed.
