

## **The Arts Mastery-Based Credit Procedure 2406P**

### **Demonstrating Mastery/Proficiency in The Arts**

The district will manage the assessment process so that students seeking mastery-based credit can demonstrate mastery/proficiency in art skills. Mastery-based credit can be used either for awarding credit in place of a traditional course, or for credit recovery purposes.

Students may obtain up to 1 Arts credit for passing a district-created assessment that is aligned to state learning standards. Students do not need to have attempted and failed a course before being eligible for these options:

1. Locally created written or oral test;
2. A written report on the student;
3. Student-designed portfolio of work;
4. Student presentation or oral defense of their learning in the course;
5. Hands-on demonstration of knowledge and skills; or
6. A combination of assessment approaches, as defined by the district.
