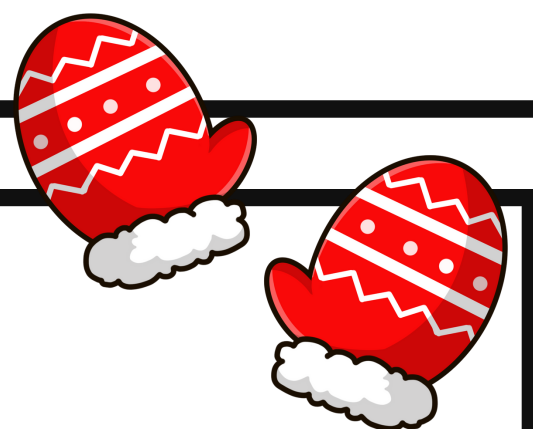
In the Classroom!
