

USD 410 BOND ELECTION INFORMATION



VOTE JAN 23 2024

USD 410 will hold a special election on January 23, 2024 with a school bond on the ballot. Voting will take place in-person at scheduled polling locations.



NO MILL LEVY INCREASE

The district can fund a \$13,350,000 bond with no mill levy increase. That means there are no new taxes for the bonds. This bond will extend the taxes already in place from the 2007 bond issue for an additional twenty years.



BOND PROJECTS

Bond projects focus on student safety, infrastructure, and facility enhancements. The proposed projects are explained on the opposite side of this flyer.

PRIMARY PROJECTS

1

Tornado Shelter

A tornado shelter at HES would be built, which would also serve as additional classrooms.

2

Heating/Air

Air conditioning would be added in HMHS gyms. Many other units are obsolete or inefficent and would be replaced.

3

Auditorium Updates

The auditorium, built in the 1970's, would be updated with new seats, sound, projection and stage floor.

4

Plumbing

Plumbing would be replaced at HES and HMHS due to the aging pipes.

5

Secured Entrances

Each main entrance would require visitors to pass through the office before accessing the rest of the building.

6

HS Gym Updates

Gym updates would include new bleacher seats, sanding the gym floor, new drop down curtains and new paint.

7

Fire Alarm System

Fire alarm system would be updated at HMHS to ensure faster response times.

8

Roof Replacement

Roofs on all buildings have reached the end of their useful life and would be replaced to stop and prevent more leaks.

9

Concrete Work

Concrete would be repaired district-wide. This would increase safety of sidewalks in high-traffic areas.

10

Playground

PreK-2nd grade playground would be renovated with safe, age-appropriate equipment and playground surfaces.

11

Greenhouse

A new greenhouse would be built to support the Agriculture Career Pathway, which is one of our most popular elective choices.

12

Exterior Work

Tuck pointing, painting and waterproofing would be completed. Windows would also be replaced at HMS.
