This annual and renewable award is “given by F. Faith Finnberg in memory of her friend Dorothy M Burrows and in remembrance of their 40 happy summers at a lakeside cabin in Lutsen”. Multiple scholarships may be awarded.

Deadline: Apri 9, 2024 – 3:00 p.m.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,200.00 (renewable)

Eligible Applicants:

Applicant must be a Cook County High School graduate who has attended CCHS full time in grades 10, 11, and 12 and has maintained at least a 2.5 GPA.

The successful applicant(s) must attend a college or university and major in English, Foreign Language, Theater, Art or Music.

The award may be renewed for up to four years as long as the student(s) is/are progressing towards a degree in any of the specified areas. If a recipient decides to change majors the award is terminated at the end of the academic year the change is made.

Applicants must complete the “Finnberg Scholarship Application” and submit a one-page paper titled: “Why I Chose to Study_____”.

Distribution of funds:

The recipient(s) will be able to obtain an annual award check from the district office during the last week in January. They will be required to sign a note stating that they are progressing towards a bachelor’s degree in one of the required areas of study.
