



## Safe Return to In-Person Learning Plan Updated 3.22.24

Because Cook County Schools is a recipient of ESSER III funds that are to be fully expended by September of 2024, MDE and the federal government require a Safe Return to In-Person Learning Plan.

<u>Screening</u>: Screen for symptoms at home. Stay home when sick.

At-Home COVID Testing: Free COVID tests are available in the school health office.

Reporting: To report a positive COVID test or any illness, contact the school office at 218-387-2271.


Face Coverings: Face coverings are optional. The district has a supply of masks available in the office.

Positive COVID Test: When a person tests positive for COVID they should stay home and isolate until:

- Fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication
- Symptoms have subsided
