- **4. Attendance Matters:** Secondary learners have attended <u>1070 MORE</u> class periods this year compared to last year. Elementary learners have attended <u>31 MORE</u> days of school this year compared to last year! **Our overall school attendance rate is 97.41%!** We appreciate you sending your learners to school when they are healthy! A couple other need-to-knows:
 - Every month we calculate each learner's attendance rate.
 - The goal is to be above 90% daily attendance every month!
 - If your learner misses 5 or more days, you'll receive a phone call as our first contact with your family!
 - If your learner misses 7 days, you'll receive a letter in the mail per the state mandated policy.
 - We have also doubled the amount of medical notes turned into the office!

The Village Family Service Center Partnership--Accessing Mental Health Services: Northern Cass School partners with The Village Family Service Center to offer school-based mental health services by providing space for licensed Village therapists to offer sessions to learners. This allows learners to be away from the classroom less, and therapists are better able to collaborate with school personnel when necessary. The therapists assess the child's needs, create a treatment plan with the family during the initial intake appointment, and determine ways to address challenges or areas of growth. Depending on the child's needs, therapy can be weekly or bi-weekly and for as long as needed. If you are seeking services to be provided at school, please first reach out to our school counselors at Northern Cass Mrs. Krinke for elementary and Ms. Davis for secondary.
