Program Goals

With the assistance and advice of school district personnel, the Board of Directors has developed this award program to encourage our district teachers to continue to grow their classrooms. Our goal is to furnish the NISD classrooms with educational resources that engage the students with new ideas which will motivate them to achieve greatness.

Grant Policies

Grant applications that do not follow the policies stated below will be disqualified.

- Grant applications must be submitted by the stated due date.
- Grant applications may not mention the teacher's name or campus in grant application.
- ❖ Borrowing grant ideas from prior years is acceptable; however; copying grants partially or in full is not acceptable.
- Grant applications must be typed and not hand written.
- ❖ All field trips or presentations must be fulfilled by May 15, 2024.
- No grants with potential liabilities will be allowed.
- Salaries are not awarded and should not be requested.
- Teacher trips are not awarded.
- ❖ Meals, transportation, food, t-shirts, hotel stays for presenters will not be awarded.
- Technology software subscriptions will not be awarded.
- Online subscriptions will not be awarded.
- College visits will not be awarded.
- FURNITURE! Only granted if approved by M&O email and lead admin. (Storage issues)
- Electronics, must be approved by IT email.

In the event a recipient of a teacher grant transfers to another school within the district, the teacher may transfer the grant awarded to the new school, if the principal and NEF executive director approve and are aware of the transfer. If the transferring teacher is one member of a group grant, the grant will remain at the school that the grant was awarded.

A teacher can receive multiple individual grants for the same funding period, provided the combined total of the grants requested does not exceed the grant limit for that funding period (\$1000).

Selection of Recipients
