The Franklin School District seeks to locate and identify any child who is potentially a child with a disability attending school and for any child 2.5 years of age up to 22 years of age residing within its jurisdiction is referred to the IEP team, who may have an educational disability. Any person may refer a child under the age of 22 years to the IEP team for reasons including, but not limited to, the following:

- Failing to pass a hearing or vision screening
- Unsatisfactory performance on group achievement or accountability measures
- Receiving multiple academic and behavioral warnings, suspension or expulsion from a child care or after school program
- Repeatedly failing one or more subjects
- Inability to progress or participate in developmentally appropriate preschool activities
- Receiving service from family centered early support and services

The child find requirements of the district apply to those children in grades K-12 who attend public school or approved, non-public private schools within the geographic boundaries of the Franklin School District, children involved in early intervention or preschool, students placed in homes for children, health care facilities or state institutions, and home schooled students. Child Find also applies to highly mobile children, homeless children, and children who are suspected of having an educational disability even though they are advancing from grade to grade.
