As part of WASD's ongoing comittment to student and staff safety and security, the District's partnership with Raptor Technologies for the 2025-26 school year. This partnership will allow WASD to streamline saftey and security related platforms into one solution.



What does this mean for ...?

VISITORS

Visitors will scan their own photo ID using the self-service kiosk in the vestibule of each school. Badges will be printed at the reception desk and handed to the visitor. If there is a question about a visitor, a notification will appear on office staff computers.

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers will start the year by scanning their own photo ID using the self-service kiosk in the each vestibule of school. Badges will be printed at the reception desk and handed to the volunteer. If there is a question about a visitor. notification will appear on office staff computers.

STUDENTS

Students in grades 6-12 will be required to wear and display their ID's each day.

Beginning after Thanksgiving Break Students will start to utilize their ID to scan into Class and also if leaving class for the bathroom, nurse, or water fountain.
