

Allen and Mary Meyer Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established to honor Allen and Mary Meyer, longtime residents of the Hiawatha area. Allen attended Kansas State University for a time prior to moving back to the Hiawatha area to farm. The goal of the scholarship is to assist a Hiawatha graduate pursuing a career in agriculture. Allen and Mary farmed and operated a dairy for over 50 years just south of Hiawatha. Mary taught school in Hiawatha for several years. Although they never had children of their own, they were devoted supporters of the youth programs through the Zion Lutheran Church and 4-H.

This \$300 scholarship will be awarded for a period of 10 years beginning with the graduating class of 2019. This is a one-time nonrenewable scholarship.

The Scholarship committee of the USD 415 Educational Foundation is responsible for selecting a recipient after consultation with Troy and Robyn Kolb. Email questions to the foundation administrator at edfoundation@usd415.org.

Selection Criteria

- Student must be in good standing with Hiawatha High School.
- Grade point average of 2.5 or better
- Preference will be given to an Ag student, with additional preference given for applicants interested in pursuing a career in Ag Education.
- Students participating in FFA will be given additional preference.

Application Process

All applicants must submit a completed application and required documentation as follows:

- Include a high school transcript signed by the HHS counselor.
- Submit the application by April 1st to the counselor at Hiawatha High School.

Payment Procedure

The total amount of the scholarship award will be paid as one installment directly to the recipient's educational institution for credit toward the recipient's tuition and expenses. Student must provide proof of enrollment by emailing a class schedule, including name of the school, to edfoundation@usd415.org by August 1st.
