

Jeffery C. Hilton Memorial Scholarship

Begun in 2010, Robert Hilton provides this Kansas State University-Salina scholarship in memory of his son, Jeffery. Jeffery received his computer technology degree from that institution. A 1996 graduate of Hiawatha High, Jeffery passed away from a massive heart attack at the early age of 30.

The scholarship committee consists of at least four members including the Hiawatha USD 415 Educational Foundation scholarship committee and a representative of the Hilton family. The committee is authorized to establish eligibility criteria for the recipient of scholarship monies. The criteria of the scholarship may be amended periodically as determined and recommended by the scholarship committee. Email questions to the foundation administrator at edfoundation@usd415.org.

This is a \$1,000 scholarship which may be renewed only by submitting a new application form each year along with a college transcript of college courses completed. Those applying for renewal will compete for the scholarship with new applicants.

The selection of a recipient for the scholarship will be based primarily on financial need along with criteria listed below.

Selection Criteria

- Recipient must be a graduate of Hiawatha High School.
- Recipient must have a high school grade point average of no less than 2.0.
- Recipient must have a financial need.
- Recipient must demonstrate potential success in post high school training.
- Recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student (minimum of 12 credit hours) at Kansas State University-Salina.
- Applicant must submit a completed application form.
- Applicant must submit three reference questionnaires with their application form. The references should include two educationally related reference and one non-educationally related reference.
- Participation in extracurricular activities, community involvement, and work history will be considered.
- By graduation, applicant must have completed at least eight units of academic credit from Hiawatha High School.

Application Process

All applicants must submit a completed application and required documentation as follows:

- 3 signed reference questionnaires must accompany this application.
- Include a high school transcript, signed by the HHS counselor.
- If applying for renewal, an unofficial college transcript is required instead of a high school transcript.
- Submit the application by April 1st to the counselor at Hiawatha High School.

Payment Procedure

The total amount of the scholarship award will be paid as one installment directly to Kansas State University-Salina for credit toward the recipient's tuition and expenses. Student must provide proof of enrollment by emailing a class schedule, including name of the school, to edfoundation@usd415.org by August 1st.
