

Kiley Ramey Memorial Scholarship

Kiley Ramey lost her life in a car accident while a student at Hiawatha High School. This scholarship was established by Gary and Linda Ramey in remembrance of their daughter. Kiley's greatest love in life was helping other people and animals. Her scholarship emphasizes service to others.

The \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from Hiawatha High School who will enroll in any form of higher education such as a university, college, community college or trade school. This is a one-time nonrenewable scholarship.

The scholarship committee consists of Linda and Gary Ramey. The criteria of the scholarship may be amended periodically. The Hiawatha USD 415 Educational Foundation manages this scholarship. Email questions to the foundation administrator at edfoundation@usd415.org.

Selection Criteria

- Recipient must graduate from Hiawatha High School.
- Recipient must have a high school grade point average of no less than 2.0.
- Recipient must enroll as a full-time student (minimum of 12 credit hours) at a trade school, community college, college, or university.
- By graduation, applicant must earn at least eight units of academic credit from Hiawatha High School to be eligible.
- Applicant must write a paragraph or two, but no more, describing how you have followed Kiley's example of helping others or, if you have not helped others, how you plan to do so in the future.

Application Process

All applicants must submit a completed application form and required documentation as follows:

- Paragraph describing how you have helped others or plan to help others in the future.
- Include a high school transcript signed by the HHS counselor.
- Submit the application by April 1st to the counselor at Hiawatha High School.

Payment Procedure

The total amount of the scholarship award will be paid as one installment directly to the recipient's educational institution for credit toward the recipient's tuition and expenses. Student must provide proof of enrollment by emailing a class schedule, including name of the school, to edfoundation@usd415.org by August 1st.
