We have been given the opportunity to provide your child with the 4-hour Defensive Driving Course called *Alive at 25*. We will offer the course and the certificate at no charge to you or the school due to the generosity of the NDDOT, the North Dakota Safety Council, and Linton Public School.

This course helps prevent driving decisions that can have tragic consequences and provides the students with the tools to resist participating in risky driving behaviors through interactive videos, shared driving experiences and workbook activities.

Alive at 25 has many benefits besides the educational portion. This 4-hour course is approved for an insurance discount and a point reduction in North Dakota but was created to reduce teen fatalities. The class is offered to the public statewide for \$60.00; or \$85.00 if court appointed.

Your student will be registering themselves for the class during the school day. We need your help to ensure the student and the school have all the information needed to complete the registration process. Please be sure your student has this information readily available. Your student will need to know the status of driver license whether they are **un-licensed, permit, valid, suspended or revoked** and will need to receive this information by: **03/22/2024**.
