Parents/Guardians will need to provide transportation to the high school; Transportation home will be provided by the school.

A brief parent/guardian and student presentation will be held from 7:30 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. Parents will be dismissed at 8:15 a.m. Students will stay for orientation and will be bused home at 10:30 a.m.

During orientation students will receive a copy of their schedule, and will have the opportunity to follow their schedule to familiarize themselves with classes, meet other freshmen, meet teachers, and reconnect with peers. In addition, students will meet upperclassmen who will help make the transition to the high school successful.

Open House will be held Thursday, September 7 at 6:30 p.m. HS Auditorium. After a brief presentation, parents/guardians will follow your student's class schedule for the remainder of the evening.

Students will receive a printed class schedule during Advisory on Wednesday, September 6 (the day before Open House). Please remember to bring their schedule with you.

★ Senior College Planning

Senior College Planning Sessions are on Thursday, September 14 - The *morning session* is **in- person** from 7:30 a.m. - 8:25 a.m. in the Auditorium, and the *evening session* is **virtual** from 6:30 p.m. - 7:30 p.m. *the link will be sent out at a later date.* Seniors attendance is **REQUIRED** for one of the sessions. - ★ Bus Transportation is managed by Central Services and provided by CREC Transportation Solutions. If you need to change your student's transportation requirements due to a move, please call Central Services directly at 860-844-5253. For all other busing questions or concerns, please call CREC Transportation Solutions directly at 860-509-3783. Bus route lists will be e-mailed to you directly by the end of the day on August 18, if do not have access to e-mail or do not have an email on file, please call Central Services.
- ★ Parking for Seniors Seniors who have completed the application process and have received their parking pass can begin parking on the first day of school, Tuesday, August 29 (unless noted otherwise).
- ★ PLC Every Thursday / Late Arrival for Students (unless noted otherwise) Every Thursday morning from 7:30-8:30 a.m. is PLC (Professional Learning Communities) for teachers to meet and work collaboratively on goals they set out each year to increase student achievement. School transportation still runs a regular schedule and students are encouraged to take the bus at their regular scheduled time. The supervised study hall (SDA) locations reserved for students during PLC are the community gym, cafeteria, or media center (library). This is a great time for students to complete any school work missed or needed. If your student does not use the regular scheduled school transportation provided on this day, it is up to the parents/guardians to provide transportation arrangements to ensure that your student arrives at school on-time for their first period class.
- * Attendance Daily and on-time attendance at school is expected of all students. Please review the attendance policy in the student handbook. To report an absence, an early dismissal or late arrival, please email GMHSAbsent@granbyschools.org or call the attendance line at 860-844-3014 #2 and leave a clear detailed message. As a courtesy to parents, if your student is absent from school and we have not yet heard from you, you will receive a personal phone call requesting the reason.
- ★ Communication Sources for School Events Communication between school and home occurs through both our weekly email updates and quarterly Newsletter to families. To ensure that you are receiving our updates and important information, please review and confirm that your email address is current and on file. Communication to students is communicated directly to your students' granby gmail account, and through our daily morning communication announcements. For your convenience, our daily morning communication announcements to students are also posted on our website homepage under "Daily Bulletin", while on the homepage you can also view our "Events Calendar" for any current or upcoming scheduled school events.
- ★ The Student/Parent Portal is an online resource which lists student assignments and grades. This online grade book is updated regularly by the classroom teacher and should be checked on an ongoing basis by both you and your student. Questions related to postings on the portal should be directed to the classroom teacher via email. If you do not have an account, please call the main office at 860-844-3014 for assistance in creating an account.
- ★ Student ID Cards / Picture Day New photos & Student ID Cards will be taken on School Picture Day on September 19. Student ID Cards will be distributed with your students 2023-2024

school picture upon receipt.

*Appointments/Visitors/Drop-off Zone — All scheduled or non-scheduled appointments require checking in at the main office. For first time visitors you will be asked for your driver's license to be scanned in order to obtain a visitor's badge. Once in the system, you will just need to provide your name and a visitor's badge will be printed out for you. If you need to drop something off for a student/staff/nurse/department, please ring the buzzer to gain entrance to the vestibule where our "Drop Zone" is located.
