PROGRAM LOCATION

The Granby B.E.A.R. Transition Academy is located at the Farmington Valley YMCA at 97 Salmon Brook Street, Granby, CT. Phone is 860-653-5524. Our classroom space is located in the Community Room, which has an adjacent kitchen. Students will be accessing different areas of the YMCA for health & fitness as well as internship opportunities.

CALENDAR

ABSENCES, LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DISMISSALS

Please email Kathleen Walsh (walshk@granbyschools.org) and Lisa Holm (holml@granbyschools.org) to report an absence, late arrival or early dismissal before 8:00 am.

Should a situation arise within the day that affects your student's attendance, please contact Lisa Holm @ 860-844-5257 and she will communicate this information to the program and the bus company.

Please try to plan appointments and vacations after school hours or during school breaks.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Emergency contact and health information in Powerschool will be used by the program. Please be sure you have updated this information accordingly. Lisa Holm (holml@granbyschools.org) can be of assistance if needed.

Granby Public Schools nursing supervisor, Jodi French, is providing support to the program. Please note there is NOT a school nurse on site daily. Should your student become ill during the school day, Granby Public Schools nursing staff will be consulted and you may be required to pick your student up.

CPR and First Aid certified staff are available at the Farmington Valley YMCA and accessible to our program in case of emergency.

MATERIALS

Your student should bring a backpack and lunch daily.

More specific information will be provided by Ms. Walsh regarding additional items students may need.

In the future, students will be shopping, preparing and cooking some lunches. More information will be provided by Ms. Walsh when this will begin.

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CELL PHONES

Students will be taught how best to manage cell phone use in the different settings they will participate in. Students will not be permitted to charge their cell phones in the classroom or on job sites so please be sure these are charged at home.

INTERNSHIPS

Student internship sites will be identified and initiated by the end of September. Student interest inventories and skills assessments will be conducted during the first month of school to support strong matches.

DRESS CODE

Students will be learning about appropriate dress given the different activities, experiences and internships they will be engaged in. Most internship sites require casual, yet professional attire. Specific information about dress code requirements will be shared by Ms. Walsh as appropriate.

COMMUNITY OUTINGS

Students will have the opportunity within the course of the school year to participate in a variety of community outings. These will be communicated in advance by Ms. Walsh.

BEST BUDDIES

Students are welcome to continue to participate in the Best Buddies program, located at Granby Memorial High School, and serve as role models for younger students. More information will be forthcoming.

PLANNING & PLACEMENT TEAM MEETINGS

Lisa Holm, Administrative Assistant ~ Pupil Services, will be scheduling PPT meetings for the transition academy. Should you wish to schedule a PPT, please inform Ms. Walsh, who will then contact Ms. Holm.

VISITING THE YMCA

Similar to our school buildings, if you need to come to the YMCA to bring your student any items, to pick him/her up early, etc., you will be required to present a driver's license to the YMCA staff at the front desk to be run through the Raptor system as part of their safety procedures.
