The purpose of this public hearing is to hear testimony on the application to waive the requirements of 105 ILCS 5/13A-2.5, which states:

Disruptive student. "Disruptive student" includes suspension or expulsion eligible students in any of ***grades 6 through 12***.

Suspension or expulsion eligible students are those students that have been found to be eligible for suspension or expulsion through the discipline process established by a school district.
