



How to Get A BCI

All school volunteers are required by RI State Law to have a BCI (Criminal Records Check) on file with the school district. A hard copy of your BCI must be submitted to the School Volunteer Office prior to volunteering. You may obtain one at the Barrington Police Station, Rhode Island Attorney General's Office, or at any of the following BCI drop-in dates at our schools:

Wednesday, September 6th

Barrington Middle School- Outside under front awning
9:00am-10:00am

Thursday, September 7th

Hampden Meadows School- Outside under front awning
9:00am-10:00am

Friday, September 8th

Nayatt School- Front of School (weather permitting)
9:00-10:00am

Monday, September 11th

Sowams School- Outside under front awning
9:00-10:00am

Tuesday, September 12th

Primrose School- Front of School (weather permitting)
9:00-10:00am

Wednesday, September 13th

Barrington Middle School- Outside under front awning
9:00am-10:00am

There will also be BCI drop-in opportunities announced at several schools' fall PTO meetings.

PLEASE BRING:

-Photo ID and a photocopy of your photo ID (front and back). The event will be outside so we won't have access to a printer and must have a copy of your ID (front and back).

-A check (cash not accepted) for \$5.00 made out to "BCI"

NOTE:

Revised policy requires all Barrington Public School volunteers to update their BCI every two years.

We do not have access to BCIs that you may have completed for other purposes such as coaching, scouts or employment.

You **must** provide a hard copy of your BCI to the school department. Only BCI-approved volunteers are permitted to work with students.
